  - B. Allow the Holy Spirit to reveal to you your destructive habits.
- 3. Connect to the Source of Love. 2 Corinthians 5:14
  - A. Learn the difference between flesh and Spirit.
  - B. Depend daily on the Holy Spirit's power.
- 4. Choose to Love. 1 Corinthians 13:4-7
