Message Summary: There is a belief among many people and even Christians that Jesus, the Word of God, is a New Testament figure exclusively. While we may believe that He has existed from eternity, we have a difficult time seeing Him in the Old Testament in anything other than prophecy. Nothing could be further from the truth. He has simply been hiding in plain sight.
