Message Summary: How enthusiastic were you about your chores growing up? Probably not much. We did them out of sense of duty or fear of consequences if we didn't. Nobody was excited to do chores. Here at Hope Chapel we want every person to serve the Lord enthusiastically. Serving should be a joyous experience not drudgery – duty – or for some spiritual obligation, we are trying to fulfill. God wants us serving Him with excitement...with zeal. Today we find how this is even possible.
