**Message Summary:** The success of our next generation, whether it is the church, our family or our nation, depends on how faithful we obey our God by training others with the glorious truths of Christ in such a way that they passionately, devotedly teach others in the Holy Spirit. The question is what am I passing on to the next person? And does that legacy have eternal implication? Deuteronomy 6:1-9 gives 5 ways to turn your house into a home and your home into a church.

## **OUR HOME: A CHURCH**

Deuteronomy 6:1-9

FIVE WAYS TO TURN YOUR HOME INTO A CHURCH:

1. **Our home is where God is TOP priority.** Vs. 4
2. **Our home is the starting point of LOVE for God:** vs. 5,6
3. **Our home is a place of DAILY discipleship:** vs. 6,7

FIVE KEY AREAS FOR CHILDREN:

1. Disciple them to love God. Vs.5
2. Disciple them to remember to thank God. Vs. 10-12
3. Disciple them to know the ways of God. Vs.13
4. Disciple them on how to choose a mate. Deut. 7:2-4
5. Disciple them to deal with peer-pressure. Deut. 7:5-7

4. **Our home is a place where God's Word is LIVED out in lifestyle:** vs.8

5. **Our home is where the parents LEAD by spiritual authority:** vs. 9
