Message Summary - Just about everyone who has ever lived has experienced a broken heart to some degree or another. But then there are others who have been affected so adversely by events in their lives that they can be described as *broken people*. We can respond by questioning why God allows bad things to happen *or* we can be loving toward the broken in His Name and thus become a part of the solution.
