

Hope Chapel - "2022 Easter Season Series"

Message Summary: The entire Bible revolves around one unique historical event; the sacrificial death of Jesus on the cross. We're reminded today of eight great deals offered to anyone who trust in Jesus Christ as their Savior. It's called "God's Great Exchange". An exchange is when you give something to someone else and they respond by giving back something else in exchange. Through Jesus' death on the cross, believers now receive spiritual, physical, material and emotional health.

God's Great Exchange

- 1. Jesus took our punishment so that you might receive forgiveness of sins. Ephesians 1:7**
- 2. Jesus was for us wounded so that you might be healed. 1 Peter 2:24**
- 3. Jesus was made sin, with our sinfulness so that we might be made righteous with His righteousness. 2 Corinthians 5:21**
- 4. Jesus took our death so that we might receive His life. Romans 6:23**
- 5. Jesus became poor with our poverty so that we might become rich with His riches. 2 Corinthians 8:9**
- 6. Jesus bore our shame so that we might share His glory. Hebrews 6:6**
- 7. Jesus experienced our rejection so that we might have His acceptance as a child God. Matthew 27:45-46**
- 8. Jesus became a curse for us so that you might receive the blessings. Galatians 3:13,14**

2. If Jesus bore our sickness already, why do most people bare sickness and never ask God to heal them?
3. Was it the cross or our sins that killed Jesus? Explain?
4. Deuteronomy 28:48 describes four elements of absolute poverty. When did Jesus experience poverty for you and why?
5. How has God prospered you in Christ? Is that prosperity more than money can buy? Explain.
6. How did Jesus experience shame for us?
7. Point #8- God wants us to live in blessings and abundance (John 10:10).
What does it take for Christians to live in that abundant life?

APPLY IT (15 min)- Which of the 8 areas are you willing to exchange with God in order to live the life Christ's death provided for? Make that decision and pray to receive.
