Message Summary - Pitfalls of familiarity is the incapacity to sense God at work in our midst. When the American Church becomes too familiar with the sacred things of God, we lose the capacity to appreciate our blessings and fail to see the hand of God working all around us. We cease to recognize His love, His provision, His forgiveness and His intervention in bring healing to our lives and families.

OPEN IT – (10 min) What does the cliché "Familiarity breeds contempt" mean?

EXPLORE IT – (60 min) What does the story in 2 Samuel 6:1-11 tell us about Uzzah's irreverence toward the Ark of God?
