

#### **Bible Never Said Series – part 4**

**Message Summary:** There is a widely held belief that God doesn't really care what you do with your life as long as it's something good. As long as you're not a thief – or hurting others – or doing something illegal. It's your life and you can do what you want with it. This isn't entirely true. God's Word never said that. Often our behaviors demonstrate what we really believe and this is certainly true with this belief about God. There are some dangers with this belief. Once again, even this subtle belief hinders our relationship with God.

### **LIFEGROUP Questions**

**Begin It (5min)** – Open Prayer & Praise

**Open it (10min)** – People may not actually verbalize the belief that God doesn't care what we do with our lives, but how do they live this way?

**Explore It (60min) - Discussion Questions:**

1. Five Biblical reasons were given that demonstrate God cares very deeply about our lives. Discuss each one and share why they matter. How do these points teach that what we do with our lives matters greatly to God?
2. Which of the five reasons speaks to you the most?
3. Do you have areas of your life where God doesn't have much say in what you do? If so, are you willing to allow Him access to this part? Does this scare you?
4. How much would your life be different if you lived this way?

**Apply It (15min):** What are the steps you need to take this week to allow God more say about your life?
