HOMETOWN MISSIONARY

Romans 10:1-15

1. **HEART'S DESIRE for lost people (relatives & friends) to be saved.** v.1

2. **PRAYER TO GOD for lost people (relatives & friends) to be saved.** vv.1-3

3. **MISSIONARY SENT for lost people to be saved.** vv.4-15
 - A. **FIND lost people.**
Build authentic relationships with people.

 - B. **TELL lost people.**
Share what Jesus Christ has done for you.

 - C. **BRING lost people.**
Bring people with you to Christian gatherings.

LifeGroup Questions:

BEGIN IT (5 min) – Sing praise to the Lord and pray that God leads the study.

OPEN IT (10 min) - When have you known someone who refused to listen to any advice or instruction?

EXPLORE IT (60 min) – Read Romans 10:1-15 and review Sunday's sermon outline together with your group. Stop at each point allowing people to share their additional comments or notes taken while listening to the sermon. Now answer these remaining questions:

1. How can a person have great zeal for God or religious activities and yet be misguided?
2. What groups of people in our society resemble the unbelieving Jews of Paul's time?
3. In Rom. 10:9,10, what are the simple instructions given regarding personal salvation?
4. Why is both believing with the heart and confessing with the mouth important for salvation?
5. In Rom. 10:14,15 who does God use before people call out to God for salvation?
6. Explain in your own words the simple steps of: FIND, TELL, BRING.

APPLY IT (15 min) - Who in your circle of friends and family needs to hear about what Christ has done for you? Spend extended time now praying for this list of people.
