Sunday Series: *The Holy Spirit-Another Helper*

Message Summary: The Holy Spirit blesses believers with spiritual gifts, but sadly, many people are ignorant about them. In this message, we learn why we have spiritual gifts and the reason they are still relevant to us today. We also learn that in order to utilize and develop our spiritual gifts, we must ask the Holy Spirit to fill us.

The Gifts of the Holy Spirit

1 Corinthians 12:8-10

1. Spiritual Gifts – Unity in Diversity

- A. Gifts are given not earned.
- B. Gifts are not the goal; edification is the goal.
- C. Gifts are available to all believers.

2. Spiritual Gift vs. Spiritual Fruit

- A. Fruits of the Spirit – Character of Christ (Galatians 5:22,23)
- B. Gifts of the Spirit – Works of Christ (1 Corinthians 12:8-10)
- C. Spirit-filled life maintains both the character and the works of Christ.

3. Spiritual Gift of Speaking in Tongues

- A. Personal faith edified (1 Corinthians 14:4; Jude 20)
- B. Prayer life & Praise life enhanced (1 Corinthians 14:2,14,15)
- C. Prayers gain 100% results (Romans 8:26,27; 1 John 5:14,15)

OPEN IT (10min) What is one unique talent or ability you have (whether useful or pointless)?
